First, regarding the quizzes, it might be more effective if we could complete them at home instead of right after the lesson. This would give students more time to review the material, reflect on the concepts, and thoroughly work through the math problems at their own pace. Second, for the chapter materials in the modules, organizing the lecture slides into separate folders for each week could make it easier for students to quickly find and follow the content. This would also help us better prepare for exams by clearly identifying which parts to review. These are just small adjustments that could make an already great course even more helpful.
